## No visits

Protection against infection is of major importance – more than ever. It is our duty to reduce the risk of infection through the best possible hygiene and precaution. To minimize the risk of the coronavirus being carried into the hospital by visitors, we need strong regulations.

**Visits to our patients are not possible until further notice.**

In extraordinary cases there can be exceptions between 4 and 6 p.m. They need, however, to be coordinated with the attending hospital doctor.

This visitor must be registered and has to follow the protection rules.

Have you been in a risk area in the past 14 days?
